- 4. Beach Clean-up Scheduled for 4th of June 9-11 am at Peggotty Beach.
 - Harbor United Methodist Church will spread the word and sponsor a pizza lunch
 - Beach has been very clean, we can spread to the marsh and parking lot as time permits. Big items can be collected by DPW
 - NOAA Network of Marine Debris Program try to catalog items and report.
 Corey has used in VA
 - Kelly to check with beautification committee to borrow grabbers
 - Harbor United Methodist Church will bring some trash grabbers
 - Kelly to inquire with environmental club and bring DPW bags
- 5. Brian Taylor NSRWA:
 - NSRWA has organized beach grass plantings at Peggotty beach twice. Funded through Scituate Education Foundation and planted / provided educational opportunities to Jenkins elementary school 2nd graders and 4th graders. Held in late spring gave lesson about erosion. Each student was provided with a clump of beach grass. Coordinated with the NSRWA staff scientist and with Scituate conservation commission. NSRWA would be willing to help organize and lead education / planting again, but needs funding to purchase plants.
 - Harbor United Methodist Church holds monthly summer fish fry (1st Friday in June, July, Aug, Sept) to raise money for non-profit work – may be able to help in 2023.
 - Want to plant beach grass while dormant between Nov 15 and April 15
 - Fencing is maintained by local Peggotty resident; the resident would like more fencing if we're able to find funding

- Minot renourishment complete project would require \$8,000,000 to fund. Permits expire year end.
 - CPC application was denied.
 - Applying to CZM for \$2,000,000 (max available per year for a project); town would fund \$200,000.
 - Could try to extend permits
 - Project is technically shovel ready, but the funding is difficult
- Coastal Resiliency: \$400,000 funding to study how to raise Cole Parkway parking lot
- Discussed Trash Skimmer for harbor but this would fall under harbor master
- 7. First Cliff Beach Access:
 - Conor pulled town plot information appears the plots to the North would have public beach access, but plots to South are privately held beach property
 - Sent a proposal to Conservation on 4/19 to discuss making a path for local residents to use across town plot
- 8. Food Truck update: permission granted to The Dingy, owned by Katherine Neil for beaches this summer.
- 9. Metco: Draft proposal is being put together.
 - Police chief does not have concerns with additional stickers being issued.
 - 61 families participate in Metco, however probably 10-15 families would pursue a sticker
 - Would need to be purchased in person at City hall with vehicle registration: 1/ household
 - Annual list of families to be provided to Town Clerk to reference.
