**Fall Voting Meeting**

**October 27, 2022**

Meeting called to order at 7:00.

Bill Richter, Director of Pilgrim Festival Chorus, came in to talk about his group and give a bit more information on the project he has requested funding for. He thanked the group for past support.

Minutes from September 15<sup>th</sup> were approved as submitted.

Question arose about the Scituate Sister City Project's remaining \$800 grant allocation not used from last year's approval. The request to revise last year's grant proposal was denied. These unused funds will go into available funds for this year's requests.
