Scituate Beach Commission plan to refurbish/brand the town's beach trash barrels. - Steven Tripp advised the SBC needs to do additional work on the plan and will let us know if/ when a meeting with the EDC should be scheduled.

The EDC Website – (Ted) Installation of the EDC website should be completed by 3/31.

Status on size on size of signs for Town's new buildings –Laura has discussed with both the Police and DPW and received approval for larger sized signage for certain town buildings. Way- Finding for pedestrians –Scituate Harbor (Laura & Ted) discussed but not resolved. Will involve installation of directional kiosks to assist people visiting the Harbor area.

“Sea Scituate” – For tee shirts, sweat shirts and mugs. Monte presented two options for the town to consider. Laura will advise next steps.

The Greenbush Vision Plan & Zoning Audit - Ted

Next steps following Ted's presentation to the BOS on 1/24 and planning. Ted sees this as a directional workshop [rather than a formal Charrette] that would be conducted in May on the 13th or 20th possibly at the Town Library. Important Sewer and Zoning issues need to be resolved.

Development Plans – Rt. #3A & First Parish (Colin) tabled for discussion at our April meeting.

Other Business

- Scituate booth at the New England Boat show was again a success and well received.
- The Chamber of Commerce “Scituate in Your Pocket” booklets. Voted to provide \$750 in funding subject to prominent use of the Sea Scituate logo on the cover.
- **Approved the minutes for the February 8, EDC meeting.**
- Approved and signed pending bill in the amount of \$995 to McKenzie Catering for a luncheon re: the expansion of the relationship with Ireland's Sister City, West Cork Municipal District. This, as required under the Municipal Modernization Act.
