 - Revenue was approximately \$5,400
 - Cost was approximately \$390
 - Net proceeds will be distributed to Sister City Committees based on tickets sold
 - Next year, considering starting earlier in the year

 - For next year
 - Develop an elevator speech for the Sister City Committees
 - Use three tents next year if possible to avoid crowds (usual charge is \$500 per tent)

 - Getting cups/mugs, tote bags, or shirts for sale
 - Get matching shirts for volunteers
 - Mailing list has expanded; Maria Lobo to enter emails
 - Content for IG/Facebook needed; may look for high school volunteers
- 4. Artist collaboration
 - Inquiring about collaboration with Danny Spinola from Praia
 - He is here for August but will also come back in the fall
 - The South Shore Arts Center is looking to highlight artists, so it could be good timing
- 5. Winter film festival
 - Theater will host movies for a \$10 donation
 - One night per week for four weeks in Jan/Feb
 - Business keeps concessions
 - Will source film ideas from the Cape Verde Film Festival
- 6. Feast of Santa Catarina
 - St. Mary's Church will have a Mass in Scituate on Nov 25
