The Town of Scituate is in the process of developing an integrated multi-modal pedestrian and bicycle pathway as part of a greater mission to construct an integrated network of pathways for recreational use throughout Town. The proposed project is part of this larger master planned project that aims to connect the entire Town of Scituate with a series of recreational bike paths and trails from the western part of the Town, paralleling the Route 3A greenway, and the waterfront on the other, and creating a nearly 10-mile loop around the Town.
