Along with Mark Catesby, Alexander Wilson, and John James Audubon, Louis Agassiz Fuertes was one of the great painters of American birds. From 1899 until 1927 when he died prematurely, Fuertes was the finest bird painter of his generation, and really since Audubon. During the five years leading up his death, he was working on his finest project - illustrating Forbush's three-volume work *The Birds of Massachusetts*.
