

Ladies & Gentlemen:

In accordance with Chapter 130, section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has re-examined the waters of Cohasset Harbor (MB: 10), in the Towns of Cohasset and Scituate. As a result of this examination, the Division has determined that a portion of Cohasset Harbor, The Breakwater (MB: 10.5), no longer meets the established criteria for the harvest of shellfish and the status of the area has been changed to **"CLOSED TO SHELLFISHING"**.

Under the authority of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 130, Sections 74A, and 75, the status of the below defined area has been changed to **"CLOSED TO SHELLFISHING"** and closed to the taking of all shellfish. Digging, harvesting or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest or collect shellfish and the possession of shellfish from the below defined area is prohibited.

Under authority of 322 CMR 7.01 (7) all permits issued thereunder are hereby conditioned to prohibit the taking, selling or possession of shellfish from the below defined areas.



The Breakwater

"The waters, flats and all tributaries of that portion of Cohasset Harbor, in the Towns of Cohasset and Scituate, east of a line drawn from the southern corner of the dock at Whitehead to the southeastern corner of the dock at Bellarmine House to the northern end of the breakwater and continuing to the "NO SHELLFISHING" sign located approximately 300' east of the base of the breakwater on Bassing Beach and west of a line continuing to the dock at Whitehead."
