- 1. Meeting called to order
  - Motion by Kate, second by Rich
- 2. Review & accept meeting minutes from August 2023
  - Motion by Rich, second by Kate
- 3. Election of Board
  - Kelly Bower nominated as Chair (4/0 in favor), Kate Dahlstrom nominated as Vice Chair (4/0 in favor), Rich Beekman nominated as clerk (4/0 in favor)
- 4. Coastal Management Update not discussed
- 5. Cleanups
  - Museum beach cleanup 11 in attendance, more trash and bottles than anticipated, clear there are parties, left in good shape
  - 10/14 at humarock is next cleanup
- 6. Beach Reports
  - Sand Hills, Minot, Humarock available to Chris, he selected Humarock
  - Museum: a lot of trash but new dune sign is up, enjoy the sign
  - Peggotty: Recent heavy flooding, likely from marsh side, very deep.
  - Egypt: The shower is up but no new bathroom this season, water safety stations not put out
  - Minot: No water safety station there either
  - Peggotty: Rich has not noticed trash, Kate said she went recently and was surprised how much trash there was
  - General: No safety stations this seasons, ring bells when mobi mats go out next year
  - General: Chris asked about weekly tractor raking, like FL. Conservation and seaweed removal brought up as possible challenges. Nahant does it. Ask Conservation

#### 7. Resident Survey

- Rich read out high level results; Minot favorite beach due to distance & aesthetic, 80% drive to beach, 18% walk, Sand Hills & Egypt least favorite due to aesthetic & parking, mix of why people go to the beach, Peggotty overwhelmingly most littered, 67% know of floating wheelchairs, 56% against more day passes, mix of respondent ages
- Rich will share survey, ask to get on town weekly updates

### 8. Beach Sticker Proposal

- Kate History of proposal from sunrise to bigger ambition, more day passes
- Visitor sticker revision idea 5 weekdays/no holidays/no weekends, all 5 beaches
  - Got email from Selectboard member (Karen) think bigger, rethink out of town sticker idea completely.
  - Kelly Recreation feedback is no non-resident except Humarock
  - o 2019 change \$75 to \$100 for out of town stickers
  - o Move \$35 to \$50 for sticker, has been \$35 forever. Seniors \$40
  - Violation fees now \$25 or \$50, move up to \$100
  - Kelly did math showing that taking recommendations is net positive even losing non-resident revenue
  - Kate lot of work put into out of town stickers as well
  - Kate day passes idea still moves forward, should allow non-residents access.
    Agreement on solution. Kelly how do we manage it? Needs to be online. Rich brought up the pilot of automated plate checks this year, did it happen? If automated it could work perfectly
  - Kate should we say stickers now May to Oct and no stickers necessary at all Nov-April. General consensus yes
  - Paper for beach stickers goes out in Nov, ideally have direction by then

- Now there's a bicycle commission attend meetings, fill out CPC paperwork
- Chris has volunteered
- Bike meeting next Monday. Nancy Warner has the info, we're there in support
