We had a public records request for five-years of Executive Session Minutes from a reporting agency. We will be charging for this request.

Impact bargaining has begun for the joint dispatch. Some are in the fire union, some in TOSCA and some non-union. When dispatchers call in sick, the firefighters backfill the position. In the new dispatch center firefighters will not back fill the dispatch position. In order for fire to dispatch police calls, training will be required. The police will need to be trained for emergency fire calls. We received two public records requests. This is intentional and deliberate. Mark Donovan is on the bargaining team. It is the intent of the fire department to hold us up. The money will be put in a new budget. There has been a team for the last four months; Stephen Salk, Al Elliott and Mark Thompson are on the bargaining team. We are soliciting their input to make it a collaborative effort. John Clifford is attending the meetings. The dispatchers in fire will be making more money because TOSCA makes more money than the fire union. Police is no problem.


The Board voted to adjourn the meeting at 9:35 p.m.






