[It was noted that the School Committee and the Recreation Department are co-applicants for this project.] Ms. Connolly told the Board that William Luette (VP/Scituate High School), Mark Novak (Activas) and Maura Glancy (Recreation Department) made a presentation to the School Committee on December 19th.

Mr. Meyerson said that CPC is on the next School Committee meeting agenda; they will address this issue then.

4) Old/New Business – Mr. Smith suggested that the Board discuss Historic Conservation Restrictions at a future meeting. Buildings and documents will need to be handled differently. In the future, the Board will make the CR's a part of the process.
