Motion made to approve the 7/17/2012 meeting minutes as drafted Motion seconded Motion passed unanimously – minutes approved and accepted

Treasurer's Report

Banner cost \$126.70

VSO Report

Heritage Days – thanks for the banner; great success; state Chairman Nee made appearance with handouts; four new applicants from booth visibility

Tax Exempt Status of VAC – form given to Treasurer McHugh for future purchases

Run for the Fallen – planned for September 8; Town Common to Peggoty Beach

Wreaths Across America – Vice Chairman Covell explains event is second Saturday in December; application due September 1; usually receive 7 wreaths representing all branches, plus POW; Mr. Hunt suggests that Town pay for wreath on every veteran grave in town; Chairman Kelley states that this event has had poor exposure in town in the past; Treasurer McHugh suggests that VAC contact state and Chairman Nee for state support; Mr. Hunt suggests asking the Selectman to pay for the event; VSO Knapp says that he may add this event to his annual budget request; Vice Chairman Covell reminds VAC that the Legion handles Cudworth Cemetery, but need coverage elsewhere; Chairman Kelley pledges to add this event to the Selectman's agenda

Eagle Scout Project – VSO Knapp met with Noel and his father; site visit to Hingham

VSO Office Hours – Chris is working 15 hours/week; working through files/organizing

Technology – VSO Knapp mentions Boston Globe article from August 20 which explains software download available for veterans to access self-help tools such as a distress meter and PTSD coach

Caseload – one recipient off benefits due to move to Cohasset; Chairman Kelley suggests a fall outreach

be planned; Vice Chairman Covell suggests outreach events at Run for the Fallen, on Veterans Day, and during Wreaths Across America

Chairman's Report

Chairman Kelley thanks the following members for working hard at Heritage Days and manning the booth: Mr. McHugh, Mr. Hunt, Mr. Johnson, Mr. Fountaine, Mr. Summers, and Mr. Badore

Chairman Kelley discusses the upcoming Run for the Fallen coordinated by the Military Friends Foundation to be held September 8 in Scituate; honoring 194 fallen soldiers since 9/11; event is for awareness and to honor the fallen, not a fundraiser

Vice Chairman Covell discusses need to boost participation for Veterans Day observances, including free turkey dinner at GAR Hall; looking to build comradeship amongst veterans; Mr. Hunt volunteers to send mailer to veterans on voting roll; VAC table at dinner; discussion of flag placements around town during Veterans Day observances

Public Comment

Vice Chairman Covell re-visits discussion of Wreaths Across America event; Mr. Miller and Mr. Fountaine mention Scituate Public Schools "Virtual Backpack" as a forum for promoting event

Mr. Fountaine suggests VAC shirts for public exposure
