Town of Scituate Historical Commission Meeting Minutes – November 8, 2018

1. Welcome and Call to Order

Chairman Doug Smith called to order a regular meeting of the Scituate Historical Commission at 7:04 pm on November 8, 2018 at the Scituate Town Library. 2. Meeting Minutes

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the September 20 meeting of the Commission. All members present approved the motion.

3. Form B Review

Mr. Lyle Nyberg presented the Commission with a Form B document that he had prepared for a home at 322 Chief Justice Cushing Highway. Mr. Nyberg described the home which was built in 1914-1915 in an Italian Renaissance style. The house – named Arden – was built for Robert Haven Schauffler, who was a musician, writer, athlete, and who was awarded a Purple Heart in WWI. Commission members voted unanimously in favor of submitting the Form B to the state Historical Commission for inclusion in their MACRIS database.

4. CPC Applications

Doug Smith provided copies of Community Preservation Committee applications that were tagged as having a historical component. These proposals will be reviewed at the December meeting of the Historical Commission.

5. Tercentenary Signs

Arthur Beale provided Commission members with an update on his ultimately successful effort at the DPW to find a post that fits the tercentenary sign that was restored.
