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Town of Scituate Recreation Field/Facility Permit Regulations

Field Permit - order of priority policy:

- (1) Scituate Public Schools has priority on all town fields during the MIAA designated season for specific sport. In addition, the permit status of non-profit organizations status may be impacted by unpredictable changes in the SHS Varsity game schedule or during playoff season (directed by MIAA).
- (2) The Town of Scituate Recreation Department has equal priority during high school off-season time (directed by MIAA).
- (3) Town of Scituate based non-profit organizations with 51% 99% Scituate residents with proof of appropriate non-profit status, CORI proof and liability insurance (The permit status may be impacted by SHS athletic schedule).
- (4) For-profit organizations (Scituate based has priority over out of town organizations).
 (NOTES: Within a category, priority will be given to organizations with long standing seniority)
- Special Exemption required for rate class change, see Field Coordinator.

COMMUNITY TURF POLICY

The Town of Scituate Community Turf Fields are designated community fields. They will be used primarily by SHS athletes Monday through Friday as needed. Town based youth organizations are given preference for turf use on weekends unless SHS requires use for Varsity games/playoff games.

FIELD AND FACILITY RULES & POLICIES

- 1. Any Scituate resident can use a field within posted hours and following regulations. However, groups must step aside and relinquish field for permitted groups.
- 2. You must have a copy of the permit to use the field, and have it with you at time of use.
- 3. All non-profit groups using fields must hold their own non-profit status. You cannot be sponsored by another non-profit.
- 4. Scituate High School Athletics have priority use of all town fields. If the permit your group is issued states a starting time and a high school team is finishing a game, the high school game has priority until the game they are playing is completed. Field permits may be adjusted due to SHS Varsity games and playoff games with short notice due to schedule changes and the MIAA
- 5. Field permits will be restricted during Town Meeting, Special Town Meeting, certain Scituate High School events including but not limited to Spring for the Arts, graduation, and homecoming.
- 6. Fields must be reserved for league play. League's permits include practice time. Individual coaches must request additional practice time through their league officials. Recreation Department will only permit to one designated official per organization. Blanket permitting not allowed
- 7. **Reallocation or subletting of fields by permit holder is** strictly prohibited. If permitted fields are going unused, the unused dates and times may not be assigned to non-permitted users. These times are to be turned back to the Scituate Recreation Department for allocation to other users.
- 8. If you rent a portable bathroom to place on town/school property it must be wheelchair accessible, ADA compliant and located in an accessible location.
- 9. The use of Town Fields during inclement weather is dangerous practice for players, but also it is extremely damaging to the field. If the field conditions are questionable, we are asking for your full cooperation and common sense in decisions concerning playing the game or holding a practice.
- 10. Fireworks, fires, and cooking are not allowed
- 11. Use of weapons, drugs, alcohol and tobacco are prohibited on Scituate public grounds. MA General Law ch.71, sec.37H.
- 12. Vehicles are not permitted on the fields including players, coaches and spectators.
- 13. All maintenance requests must be submitted in writing to the Field Coordinator, Kevin Devin (kdevin@scituatema.gov) Leagues should not perform any maintenance on any fields without having a signed Town of Scituate's approval.
- 14. If you are not using a field for weather or other reasons please inform Field Coordinator. The Turf Field is in high demand and if you cancel another group may want to use the field. Please contact Field Coordinator via text at 617-939-3044 as soon as possible including last minute changes.
- 15. All litter created by users must be picked up and put in proper receptacles. You must leave the field clean and in the same condition, except normal wear, as it was when you arrived. Permit status will be impacted if field is left with trash. If you arrive at a field that is covered with trash please report incident to Field Coordinator.



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Weather Policy and Field Usage Restrictions

League Officials must use their best judgment when allowing practice or playing of games. Play should be suspended if:

- There is standing water on the field and footing is unsure or slippery and/or ground is water logged or squishy (applies to all activity including football)
- Lightening or severe weather storms (cancels practice AND games)
- League officials make evening and weekend decisions.
- The Town of Scituate restricts field usage due to any reason including D.P.W maintenance program and mosquito borne diseases.

Use of a closed field or one with standing water, jeopardizes the safety of all, especially children. Future league permit approval will be impacted

In addition the inappropriate use may require additional maintenance to restore the field to safe conditions, said cost will be charged to anyone under any permit using the Town of Scituate Public Fields.

Safety & Accidents

- 1. Coaches must walk the field and surrounding area prior to use. Any potential hazards must be reported to players and opposing team players. Report hazards immediately to Field Coordinator kdevin@scituatema.gov
- 2. In the event that an accident occurs, league rules must be followed. All coaches should carry basic first aid equipment. An accident report should be completed and sent to the Scituate Recreation Department within 24 hours (See attached accident report)

The youth and adult sports organizations in Scituate provide a valuable service to the residents. Scheduling, managing and maintaining the fields are a complicated process, but is successful when everyone works cooperatively.

I agree that after the use of the field, it shall be in the same condition, less reasonable wear and tear. I have	read and will
comply with the requests of the Town of Scituate Recreation Commission.	

Should anyone under any permit using the Town of Scituate Public Fields not abide by the regulations, you could be subject, at the sole discretion of the Recreation Commission, to possible fines, suspension or loss of permit. I agree to hold harmless the Town of Scituate and/or its employees from claims for liability related to any accident that may occur to any participants and/or groups while using the Town Scituate Athletic Fields/Facilities
