## Welcome to the Scituate Dog Park Open daily from sunrise to sunset

Use of the Dog Park is at your own risk and person(s) making use of the Park shall be responsible for injuries caused by their dog(s) and shall hold the Town of Scituate, Friends of Scituate Dog Park and their representatives harmless for the same.

## **PEOPLE RULES**

- Dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the Park to avoid injury to any person(s) or dog(s).
- Remove any electric training collars, prong (spike), and choke collars before entering the Park.
- Access is restricted to the designated double-entry gates. Gates must be closed at all times. No congregating near entry gates.
- Handlers are limited to a maximum of 3 dogs and are required to keep a leash with them at all times for each dog.
- Owners must maintain effective verbal control of their dogs when off leash.
- Dogs must not be left unattended and must be in sight of their handler at all times while in the Park.
- No food, dog treats, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, toys, bikes, or smoking is allowed in the Park.
- Always pick up after your dog(s) and yourself. Be sure to Scoop the Poop!
- Children 12 years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult when in the fenced-in area of the Park. Please consider keeping children under the age of 12 from entering the Park.
- All users of the Park are subject to all fines, bylaws, and rules of the Town of Scituate.
- Owners are legally responsible and liable for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by them.
- An owner MUST IMMEDIATELY remove a problem dog from the Park. Problem behavior includes, but is not limited to, aggression such as attacking, drawing blood, threatening, and bothering dogs and people.
- All dog bites resulting in broken skin must be reported to the **Town of Scituate Police Department (781) 545-1212**.

## **DOG RULES**

- As per state laws and local by-laws, all dogs 6 months of age or older, must be properly licensed and vaccinated for rabies.
- All dogs 6 months of age or older must be spayed or neutered.
- No animals other than dogs are allowed in the Park.
