- I. **MEETING CALLED TO ORDER;** at 6:00pm. All in favor.

Ann was very involved in soccer for many years. She ran Scituate Soccer Club for many years. Scituate Youth Soccer Club supports this. Discussed that The BOS are hesitant to name fields and they may want a Plan B that they buy a bench or Plaque. Recreation Board will discuss later and vote.
