# AMENDED TOWN OF SCITUATE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

April 19, 2018

The Scituate Zoning Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing in the Selectmen's Hearing Room in the Scituate Town Hall located at 600 Chief Justice Cushing Highway on Thursday, April 19, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. to consider the following requests:

## II. APPLICATIONS TO BE HEARD:

First Application: Peter Martin of 11 Paige Street, Hingham, MA requests (i) a Special Permit pursuant to Scituate Zoning Bylaw Sections 460.2, 470.6F and 950.2B, (ii) a M.G.L. Chapter 40A, Section 6 Finding in accordance with Scituate Zoning Bylaw Sections 810.2 and 950.2D, (iii) and/or any other relief that the Board of Appeals may grant, to raze a dimensionally conforming single family dwelling in the R-2 residential zone, the Saltmarsh & Tideland Conservation, and the Flood Plain and Watershed Protection Zoning Districts at 67 Border Street, Scituate, MA (Assessor's Map 6, Block 2, Parcel 8A) on a lot which is pre-existing, nonconforming as to lot frontage, and the reconstruction of a dimensionally conforming single family dwelling thereon having an increase by more than 20% in the gross floor area.

Second Application: Diamond Development, P.O. Box 1480, Duxbury, MA requests a Special Permit/Finding pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 40A, Section 6 to raze and reconstruct the preexisting nonconforming single family dwelling at 53 Border Street, Scituate (Assessor's Map 2, Block 2, Parcel 6) increasing the gross floor area by more than 20%. In accordance with Section 32050 8B of the Scituate General Bylaw, storm water issues may be discussed as part of Public Hearings on the project.
