**NEW BUSINESS**

*Director's Report*

Mr Scheele gave his Directors report

- 1) 14 new septic plans, 4 plans waiting for Conservation approval, 8 plans waiting for Engineer revisions, 21 As-Builts.
- 2) Everything else in our office has been Covid. The 80 people that received their first shot at a clinic we held at the community building in middle of February, will be contacted to receive their second on Friday March 12, 2021
- 3) The state has not offered any more first vaccines to the Town of Scituate, we want everyone to know how fortunate we are in Scituate to have Marshfield Fairgrounds so available to Plymouth County Residents and that the Johnson & Johnson vaccine is becoming available at different sights.
- 4) All School employees will be eligible to receive vaccine as of March 11.

- 5) For homebound people the State is now setting up a call line, people must be completely homebound to be able to register for the in home shots. All of these appointments will be done the State and not the Town
