

# ***Town of Scituate – Historical Commission***

## ***Meeting Minutes – June 18, 2015***

### **1) Welcome and Call to Order**

Chairman Doug Smith called to order a regular meeting of the **Scituate Historical Commission** at **7:00 pm** on June 18, 2015 at the Little Red School House.

### **2) Approval of Minutes**

### **2) Demolition Review**

There are no pending demolition review applications at this time.

### **3) North Scituate Rail Canopy**

Arthur Beale updated the Commission on the progress of the rail canopy. The sub roof is complete and the flashing and gutters are the next step. Once this is complete the tiles can be placed back on the roof.

### **4) Tercentenary Signs**

The Commission will await CPC funding then proceed with repair and restoration of the signs after July 1, 2015. The paint can be ordered after July 1, 2015 and Arthur Beale will work with the Town to place the order for paint.

#### **5) MHC#RC 54655 – Hunter’s Pond Dam**

The Commission receive notification from US Fish and Wildlife that the Hunter’s Pond Dam is being considered for rehabilitation or removal. The Massachusetts Historical Commission is reviewing the notification and copies the Scituate Historical Commission on this notice.

#### **6) 13 Ford Place – Site Plan Review**

The Commission received a site plan review for 13 Ford Place. Although there is a historic house on the property it does not appear that it will be impacted by the proposed plan and no further action is required by the Commission.
