**QUESTION #1  
DEBT EXCLUSION**

Shall the Town of Scituate be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition two-and-one-half, so called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to design, construct and equip a new consolidated Cushing Hatherly Elementary School on the site of the existing Hatherly School at 72 Ann Vinal Road including the demolition of the existing Hatherly Elementary School on that site and the demolition of the existing Cushing Elementary School at 1 Aberdeen Drive, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto?


Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time and place of the meeting as aforesaid.
