A Message from Activitas

The newly renovated track and field at Scituate High School will host the 2019 Thanksgiving football game against Hingham on November 28th at 10am. The synthetic turf field, track, scoreboard, and spectator seating areas will be complete and we hope Mother Nature will be kind for the first game on the new field.

Please note that the Athletic Fields Renovation project is still very much under construction. This is the only scheduled event for the facility until the spring of 2020. Although the facility is not finished, we are excited that the Scituate community will get the opportunity to see the immense amount of hard work that has gone into the renovation project to date.

A few important things to note:

Facility Access - Safe and accessible means of access from the school and parking lot to the bleachers and the field will be established for the football game. The pathway from Cushing Elementary School to the track and field will be CLOSED. Spectators should stay outside of the chain link fence at the perimeter of the track. Spectators are NOT allowed on the track surface. Some of the site finishes (ie. landscaping, some ornamental fencing and gates, signage, masonry entrance piers, etc.) will be completed after Thanksgiving or in the Spring. Please stay on the walkways or you'll have a really muddy pair of shoes.

Concession/Restroom Building - The building will be constructed over the winter. Spectators shall use portable restrooms or the restrooms in the high school (adjacent to the gymnasium). Concessions for the football game will be set-up in the picnic pavilion. Considering the building subcontractor needs a staging area and will be operating in and around the proposed building with heavy equipment, it has been decided to defer final paving of the walkways in the area until after the building is complete. The compacted gravel around the picnic pavilion is NOT a final condition.

Active Construction Site - The contractor will have temporary construction fencing installed to prohibit access to other portions of the site. Access to the other parts of the construction site is strictly prohibited.

Electricity - Although the contractor has been working diligently on installation of the new power feeds, the permanent power feed may not be energized in time for the football game. If this is the case, temporary power will be provided by the Contractor to run the scoreboard, sound system and to provide power to the press box.
