## VOTE BY MAIL FORMS

All voters were sent a Vote by Mail form (Postage paid card) by the Sec. of the Commonwealth.

If you would like a ballot mailed to you please read the instructions on the form before mailing it to this office. Your registration info is at the top left corner on the form. This shows how you are registered. If you are a Democrat, you will only be mailed a Democrat ballot and if you are a registered Republican you can only receive the Republican ballot. There are many "Unenrolled" voters or those in a "Political Designation" who returned their ballot request form and failed to indicate which party's ballot (Democrat or Republican) they would like mailed and left they no phone number. All voters who did not indicate which ballot they would like for the primary will only be mailed a ballot for the November 8<sup>th</sup> State Election. If you have already submitted a request for a mailed ballot for "All Elections" please do not send another form.

If you need to make changes to your voter registration or need to register to vote, you may go online to registertovotema.com by the August 27<sup>th</sup> deadline. You may also register in this office.

When you receive your ballot please follow the instructions and be sure to sign the brown ballot envelope before returning it to this office. You may hand deliver your ballot in this office, the drop box in front of Town Hall or by mail. Please return your ballot promptly as there is data entry and filing required by this office. All ballots are counted on election day.
