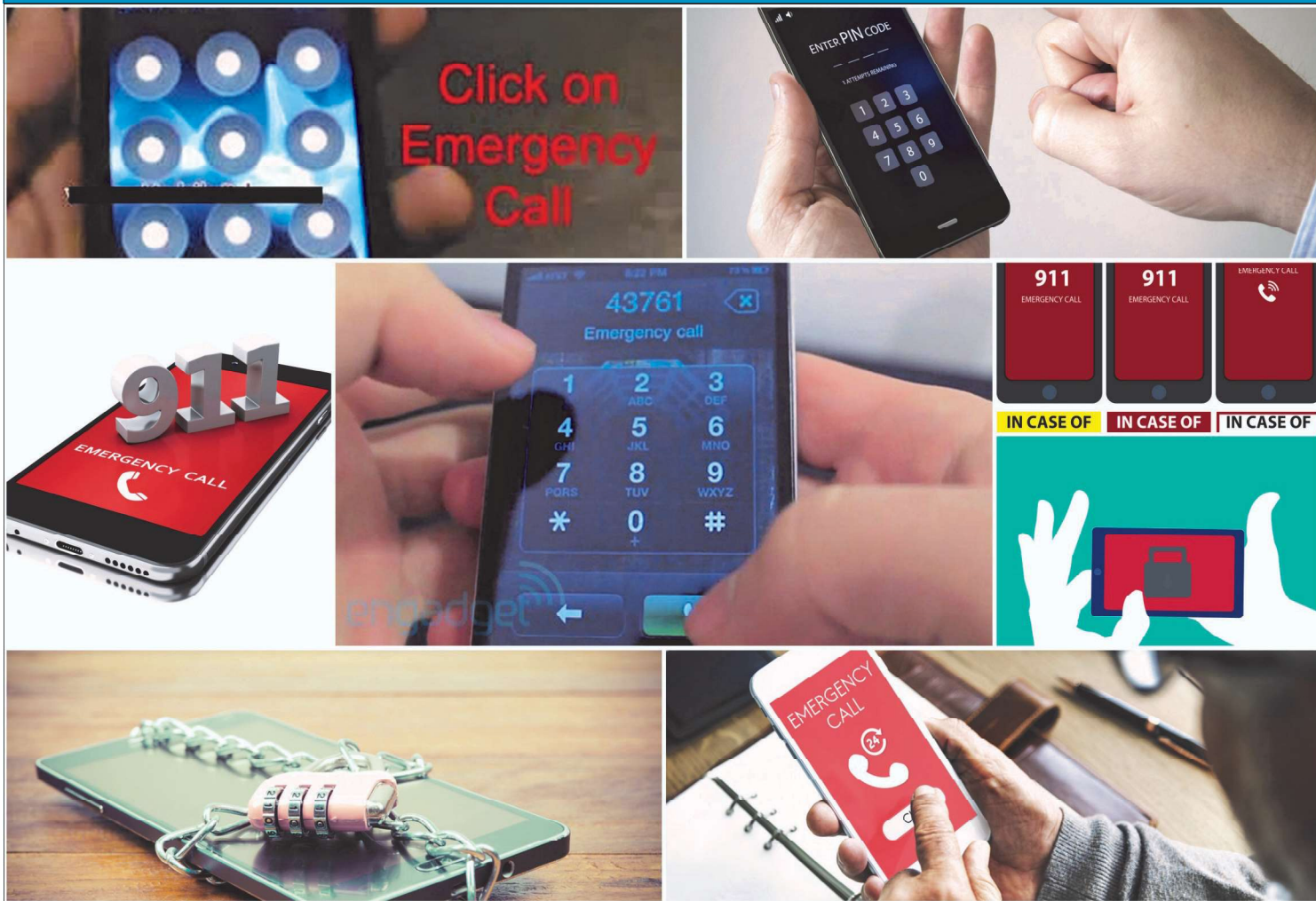

Do you know how to make an emergency call on a locked cell phone?



Does your child know how to call 9-1-1 from a cell phone? Do you know how to call 9-1-1 from a friend's cell phone that is different from yours? Placing a call to 9-1-1 from a cell phone varies by the make and model of each wireless device.

The Massachusetts State 911 Department encourages everyone to take a few minutes to become familiar with calling 9-1-1 from your cell phone and to make sure that others around you know how to make the call too. In an emergency, a PIN to access 9-1-1 from your cell phone or someone else's is typically not required. Most phones have a feature that will enable anyone to call 9-1-1 without a pass code. Please take the time to learn how to do this and share with your friends and loved ones. It could save your life!
