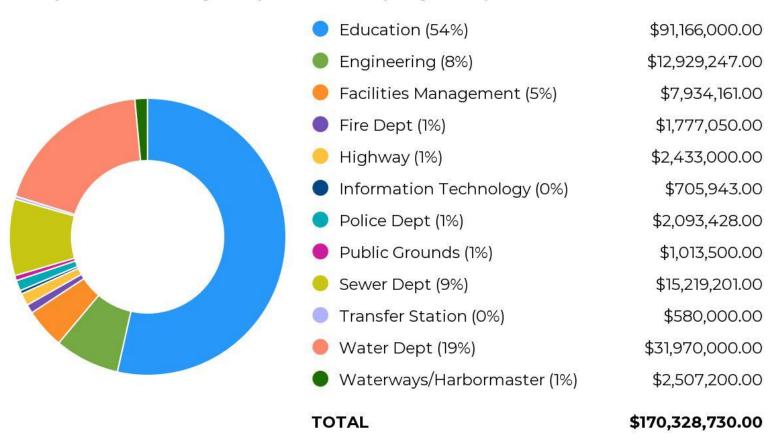


## FY2024-28 Capital Plan Highlights

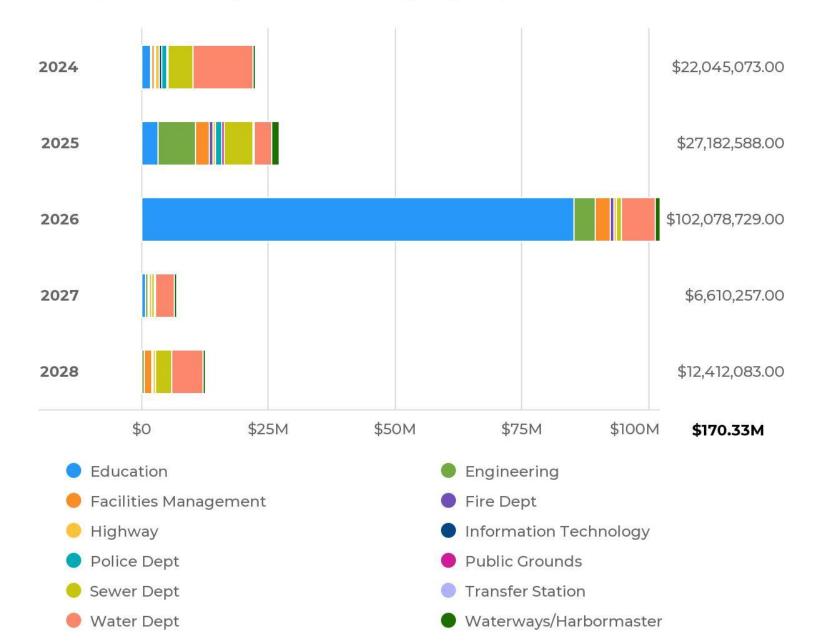
- First year using capital request software
- \* \$170.3M in capital requests over the next five years
- \* \$22M in requests for FY24; \$7.7M recommended
- \* Reflects continued investment into water system
- Continues investment in technology and public safety communications
- \* Incorporates funding for facilities improvements as recommended in town-wide facilities plan
- \* Maintains commitment to foreshore, roadway and sidewalk improvement funding
- \* Limited borrowing recommended to support plan

#### Capital Costs By Department (all years)

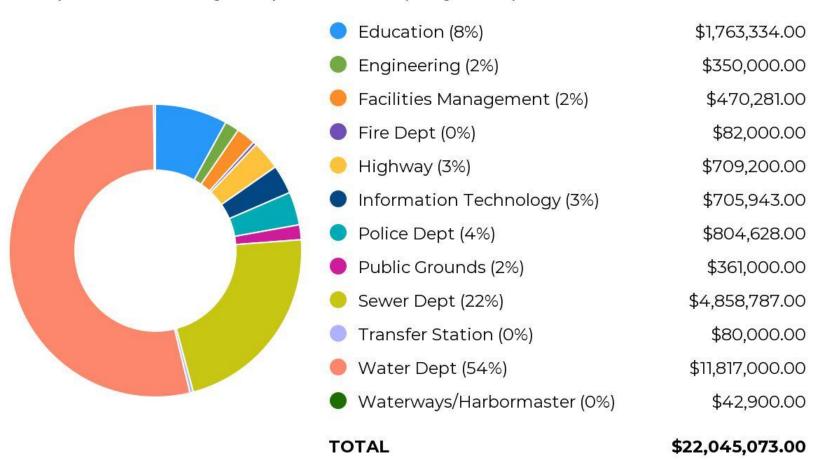


#### Capital Costs By Department (per year)

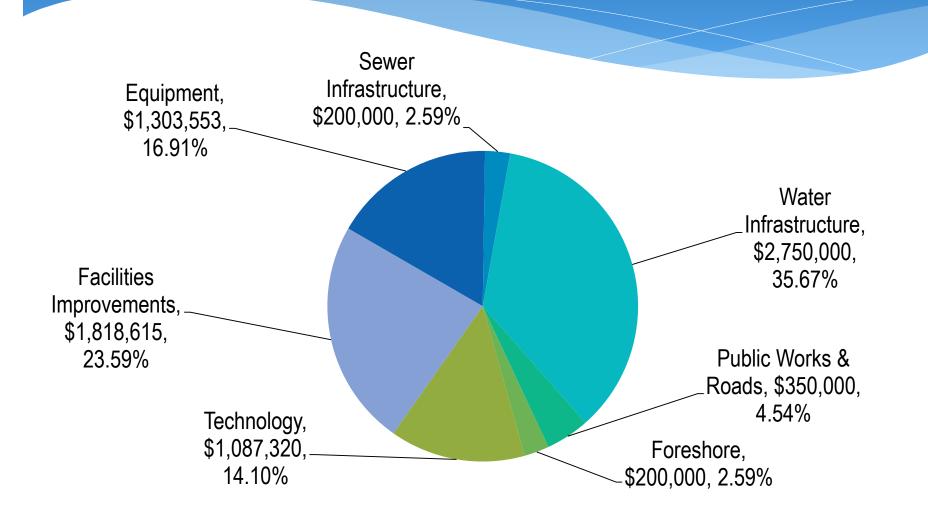


#### FY24 Requested Capital Plan

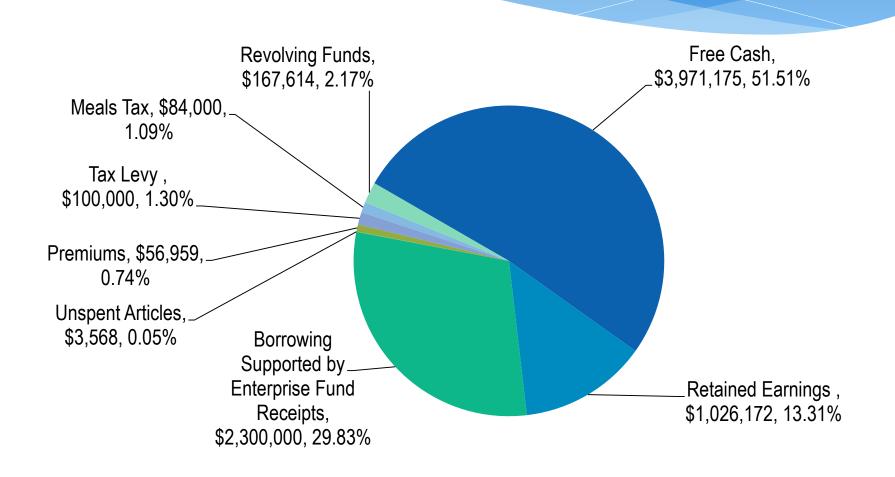
#### Capital Costs By Department (all years)

## FY24 Capital Plan Funding



#### General Fund – FY24

- \* \$4.19M of \$5.25M in requests for FY24 recommended
- \* Funding for roads, foreshore, technology upgrades for town and school, town and school building improvements and vehicles/equipment
- \* Plan demonstrates continued support for roads and foreshore protection
- \* Strong commitment to technology updates, software and public safety communications
- \* Free cash, tax levy, meals tax, premiums received from past borrowings, revolving funds and unspent capital articles are funding sources
- \* No borrowing is proposed

#### Roads and Foreshore Protection FY24

- \* Foreshore protection continues to be addressed in multipronged approach and funded from various sources
  - \* Funding in FY 24 general fund operating budget
  - \* Annual capital plan request for funding to support foreshore protection \$200K recommended for FY24
  - \* Grant funding for major construction
- \* Roadway improvements are also funded from various sources
  - \* Funding in FY 24 general fund operating budget
  - Annual capital plan request for funding to support road improvements - \$200K recommended for FY24
  - \* Estimated Chapter 90 support for roads of \$550K in FY24

#### Waterways Enterprise – FY24

- \* Recommend project proposed for \$42,900
- \* Provides replacement of one of Harbormaster's existing trucks.
- \* Retained earnings and unspent articles are funding source for \$42,900

## Water Enterprise – FY24

- \* \$517K of \$11.8M in requests for FY24 recommended
- \* Replacement of carbon at treatment plant, meter replacement program, replacement of work truck and water main replacement recommended
- \* \$9M in Dolan Well Field construction postponed due to skyrocketing costs, continued permitting and investigation into potential grants
- \* Retained earnings, premiums, borrowing and unspent articles comprise funding sources

### Sewer Enterprise – FY24

- \* \$336K of \$4.86M in requests for FY24 recommended
- Influent screen and pump replacement project of \$4.52M not recommended as facilities study has not yet been completed
- \* Inflow and infiltration measures of \$200K recommended
- \* Cyber security audit and measures of \$45K recommended
- \* Replacement of pick-up truck recommended
- \* Retained earnings, premiums and unspent articles comprise funding sources

#### Transfer Station Enterprise – FY24

- \* \$80K of \$80K in requests for FY24 recommended
- \* Replacement of pick-up truck recommended
- \* Retained earnings, premiums and unspent articles comprise funding sources
