- 4/6 Weymouth NO LATEX/ACRYLIC PAINT
- 4/20 Plymouth NO LATEX/ACRYLIC PAINT
- **5/4 Hanover** <u>Usable</u> latex/acrylic paint accepted (see over)
- 5/18 Hingham NO LATEX/ACRYLIC PAINT
- 6/8 Duxbury, Kingston & Pembroke NO LATEX
- 6/15 Scituate & Cohasset NO LATEX/ACRYLIC PAINT

If you live in the host/co-host town , OR in a town listed with a " ", just register and bring proof of residency.

- Visitors from the towns listed with an "*" NEED AN AUTHORIZATION FORM from their town's DPW, or to bring a check. Subsidized quantities may be limited. Registration and proof of residency are also required.
- Small businesses must register and bring a check to <u>SSRC</u>. Cost is up to \$59 per 25 gallons if liquid (based on container size) or 25 lbs. if solid.

- \checkmark Bring items in labeled, closed containers[†].
- ✓ Box, **don't bag** materials.
- ✓ Place in **trunk / rear** of vehicle.
- ✓ Have proof of residency, authorization or a check to SSRC if needed, ready

Accepted at all events:

From the workbench:

<u>oil based</u> paint and stains * hobby/artist supplies photography chemicals fiberglass resins adhesives solvents

From the garage:

flammable liquids and aerosols gasoline, gas / oil mixtures**†** other automotive fluids* tire and carburetor cleaners, degreasers marine, auto and spray paints

From the shed:

pesticides, herbicides, fungicides fertilizers containing pesticides pool chemicals cesspool cleaners wood preservatives

From the house:

elemental mercury mercury-containing products * drain cleaners moth balls and crystals hazardous cleaners and polishes poisons acids and bases

Accepted at some events:

motor oil*antifreeze*lead acid batteries*rechargeable batteries*latex paint **asbestosflares (Plymouth only)compact & straight fluorescent tubes *

Asbestos and elemental mercury need special packaging. CALL AHEAD 781.329.8318

Materials not accepted include:

prescription medications * pressurized gas cylinders * industrial waste radioactive materials (smoke detectors may be disposed in trash) pathological and medical waste explosives (contact your fire department)

Max 5 gal. for liquids. Bring gasoline in DOT-approved gas cans (usually red plastic). Drums require prior approval from Trident Enviro 508-229-3545.

 These materials are collected regularly by many retailers and/or towns

**<u>Latex paint (soap & water cleanup</u> is messy, but not hazardous <u>If your paint is still usable</u>

(smooth, not smelly), Recolor Paints will accept it at the **Hanover HHW event**. Go to <u>www.RecolorPaints.com</u> or call **833.732.6567** for details.

If your paint's not usable: remove lid. Absorb liquid with cat litter or paint hardener, and dispose with trash.
