High Wind Warning

Good morning,

We are under a high wind warning and are forecast to receive potential wind gusts up to 60mph along with heavy rain as a low pressure system passes west of us this afternoon into this evening. The strongest southeast winds are expected between 3pm and 10pm. This system may include thunderstorms bringing brief periods of higher winds and torrential rain.

The high winds may produce scattered power outages. If you have an outage please contact National Grid at 800-465-1212 and Eversource for Humarock residents at 800-286-2000. If you observe trees or wires down that may impact safety please contact the fire department by calling 911.

If you have a generator you may want to start it early to be sure it runs effectively. Make sure your generator is placed in a safe location so exhaust cannot enter your home. Please secure any loose items outside your home & clear storm drains in your neighborhood.

Southeast winds typically do not have significant flood impacts to Scituate but we may experience some splash over in our coastal areas at high tide 11:30pm (9').
