There is a 50/50 match requirement and we are seeking funding the Scituate CPC for \$10,000 as a match to the MHC Surveying and Planning grant. There are currently 1,018 Scituate buildings in the MACRIS database and additional funding will for the surveying of 100-150 buildings that are being identified, but not yet recorded. The surveys provide researched data and historical analysis to determine historical significance of a building and a permanent record with the Massachusetts Historical Commission.
