Maintenance of the trail is provided by the James Landing Condominium Association at no cost to the public.

## FUNDING

The James Landing Condominium Association plans to embark on a phased program to remediate invasives plantings that have spread throughout the grounds on the marsh side of the property. There

are five zones located adjacent to the Conservation Trail that are maintained as "natural" zones rather

that lawns. The Association is planning to remove the invasives within these zones and reestablish the native plantings that have been overrun by the invasive plantings. The cost for the program will be borne

by the residents of James Landing utilizing reserve funds and monthly fees. The total cost for

remediation is estimated to be \$250,000 including remediation of the Conservation Trail. The

Association will assume approximately 3/4 (\$175,000) of the total project cost.
