FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT PLANT SCITUATE

1. What is Plant Scituate about?

Plant Scituate is a Community Building Event and celebrates the uniqueness of our Town . We are a wonderful walkable small town on the South Shore with a fishing fleet, woodlands and beaches and we are proud of our community. This year we are again planting **Marigolds** in as many places as we can.

2. Why Marigolds?

Marigolds are easy to take care of and love the sun. They are long lasting and bloom the entire Summer and into Fall.

3.What colors?

Choose the colors you like. Often colors are representative of characteristics. For example: yellow and orange are both symbols for our sun . Yellow also stands for freshness, happiness, optimism, honor, loyalty and joy. Orange stands for community, warmth, heat, enthusiasm, happiness, energy and fun. Green is the color of resilience, health and good fortune. Scituate has many of these characteristics!

4. Who sponsors Plant Scituate?

5. What is the Beautification Committee?

The Beautification Committee promotes planting flowers in Scituate through a variety of community activities. The Merchant Program offers vouchers to merchants to fill planters with beautiful flowers. The Adopt a Lot solicits volunteers to plant flowers at otherwise neglected spaces. The Committee also sponsors Ship Shape Day and at our last SHIP SHAPE DAY volunteers removed 71/2 ton of debris from Scituate Road Ways.

6. What is Ship Shape Day?

Every year our community gets together the first Saturday in May and removes unsightly trash from marshes and roadsides. This year's Ship Shape Day will take place on May 1.
