Water Update:

Tack Factory Pond is +3" Reservoir is -.25"

Rainfall was .77" measured at TP

Total: 10,047,000 gallons or 1,435,285 gallons per day

Water Project on 3A is ongoing: 1,900 feet of pipe so far about 6,000 total

Gas Update

Jericho Gas Line update: completed 6 of 18 services then they will do the tie ins.

123 Gas Update: Work will be starting in mid – late September.

There will be work on Ann Vinal Gas, however, there's no update on this project yet.

Lighthouse Update: Scaffolding is schedule to start today but is weather dependent. Masonry work should be starting soon after. The top of the lighthouse is under construction and we inspected the steel substructure.

Paving Update:

Line Striping will be done soon on Country Way and Tilden Road. We are letting the asphalt set up.

Sewer Department is doing I&I Work

Ongoing work on Wellesley, Brookline and Richfield Road LCRs (lateral Connection Repairs)
