

TOWN OF SCITUATE 2021 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES

October 26, 2021

The Special Town Meeting was convened at the Scituate High School Gym, 606 Chief Justice Cushing Way, on Tuesday, October 26, 2021 with Moderator James Toomey presiding.

A quorum of "0" registered voters was declared present and the moderator called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

The weather was rainy and windy, a Northeaster, with winds expected to peak 60-75 mph later in the evening along the coast.
