

TOWN OF SCITUATE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES

October 16, 2023

The Special Town Meeting was convened at the Scituate High School Gym, 606 Chief Justice Cushing Way, on Monday, October 16, 2023 with Moderator James Toomey presiding.

A quorum of "0" registered voters was declared present and the Moderator called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Attendance was 299.

Moderator, James Toomey began the Annual Town Meeting and led with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Motion made, seconded and voted in favor to dispense with the formal reading of the warrant. The Return of Service having been examined by the Moderator and found to be in order.
