Traffic Rules and Regulations Committee Meeting Minutes March 28th, 2023 – 4:30 PM Location: Town Hall-Select Board Hearing Room

1. The meeting was called to order at 4:35 PM. In attendance: TRRC Members, Sean McCarthy, Bill Schmid, Toby Britton and liaison Ann Burbine.
2. February 21st meeting notes discussed but could not be accepted as there was not a quorum.
3. The speed on Rachel's Way was brought up by a resident however, it's a private road so the committee has no jurisdiction regarding this street.
4. Cory Miles came in to give an update on Pier 44 Redevelopment. One of the main concerns regarding this project is the concern over parking. It has been brought up that there are not enough spaces for this open park site. Cory was asking the Engineering Group to research a couple of properties that are very close to the park that the Town owns. There is a parcel of land across from the Marina that is not being used which could be repurposed as a parking area. The Engineering Group will look into the feasibility of this request.
5. There are no new updates on the two New Driftway projects as the next meetings with the Planning Board are in May.
6. Beaver Dam Road/Lawson Road Existing Crosswalk Improvements - The Engineering Group hired a Traffic Engineer from CHA to look at this intersection and come up with recommendations to improve traffic flow and safety. Jeff Chessia presented CHA's findings to the group which were classified into various levels of safety improvements. The DPW is trying to tackle some of the short-term improvements immediately.
7. Andy Brennan, a resident at 30 Curtis Street, came in to discuss the speed on Curtis Street. He requested to have one of the speed limit signs moved for better visibility as well as having a permanent radar feedback sign.
8. There is a need to have a speed limit sign put up ahead of to the flashing 20 mph sign that is located in front of the garage on Country Way.
9. Adjournment: Motion was made and seconded to adjourn at 5:39 PM. *(All present members were polled. Vote: unanimous).*
