Water system updates

Water Department update - Mark

- Full outdoor water use ban March 23-April 11 for repairs to WTP
 - o Well 17A has been running 10-14 hours per day since Monday -
 - Prepared Well 18 in case there was an emergency
- Rough draft of water tank study recommendation is to rehab the two tanks we have and not add a third.
- Water main construction moving forward will be delayed any new pipes will take 7 months to arrive
- Select Board just approve new Water Division Specs for contractors, biggest change is that we're now allowing plastic pipes (used to only allow copper) which is less expensive
- Dolan Well Field he believes they're working on permitting

Brown water update – 1 call this month from a street that is getting a new hydrant

Reservoir Project

Kevin mentioned this at the recent Select Board meeting – they want to add an intake
to the WTP directly from the Reservoir and it sounded like the expansion would then
wait until after the WTP is complete, which is about 3 years

WTP update, including Town Meeting

Bruce & Freya's notes from Select Board meeting

- New plant will be uphill from Tack Factory Pond at 443-461 CJC Hwy
- Space for the plant and room to increase capacity over time
- There will be a few lagoons on property, where they can send backwash as they treat

the water, backwash will leach through the lagoon and infiltrate GW which will also take some load off the sewer system

- 30' buffer on 3A and 60' buffer behind the plant
- The current cost estimate is about \$47MM. Each year of delay adds about \$2.4MM
 - o 2.5 from ARPA funds, potentially more from Clean Water Trust
- If approved at Town Meeting, will go out to bid late summer / early fall, complete 2.5 years from then

lan and Linda Fraser attended on behalf of their son who bought property on Old Forge Road in July. He did not know about the proposed development until now. We let them know the property was purchased by the Town in April 2021 and it was mentioned as a potential site for the WTP then. Bruce and Freya were able to share some of what they heard about construction, keeping noise low, etc. Becky suggested they now follow Planning Board agendas to track the status and attend hearings
