1. Meeting Call to Order at 7:32 pm

2. Water System Updates

Water Department Update

- Kevin Tomorrow night, 9/25/19, going before Capital Planning to request \$3M from Town Meeting to replace Galvanized pipes and older soft transite pipes, and more hydrants
- Mann Lot Road project is 2/3 complete. Testing first 1000 ft and can contact those houses as soon as testing is complete.
- Flushing 128,000gpd. Completed 3 zones in 3 weeks, 6 more to go. Goal is to flush 100 miles of pipe and hope to flush through December as long as the weather holds.
- Reservoir is down 26", Kevin shared concern about keeping up with streamflow releases.
- Ice pigging is starting sometime in October. Going after Main pipes. The plan needs to be reviewed internally.
- DEP did sanitary survey of the Water Treatment Plant. Just put \$1M for the short-term repair two months, still need long term solution.
- Water tanks Last year took out 17" of sediment. This year took out 1". Need a 3rd water tank. Need to spend money to update water tanks per OSHA.
- Scituate wells are between 90-120 feet.
- Dolan well field is not very deep it will replenish during the winter and store water through the summer. It was originally permitted in the 1990's but never built. We are planning to get permit to reopen the field and the next step is to dig deeper test wells. John B asked if we drilled any deeper to see if there's anything below this perched aquifer, Kevin referred to Dan Smith who managed this project ad is currently out of the office

- Next Selectmen meeting will be discussing water rate hike. Need money to continue to fund the ongoing capital projects.
- Water Study Public meeting, invitation only, was held in August. Tighe and Bond is planning to share deliverables. Big push has been getting uni-directional flushing program completed. The goal is to complete the study by January 2020.

Brown Water Update

- Per Mark Cloud, no complaints lately.
- Becky asked for thoughts on doing direct outreach to chronic brown water get-ters after flushing to see if there's a difference (though hard to make connection because there's so little brown water this time of year anyway). Kevin open to it, he has a list and/or the Water Dept will.

3. Single Meter Policy Update

No update. Tighe and Bond suggests using System valuation divide by total capacity = per gallon cost or Meter Hookup Cost.

4. Outdoor Water Use Restriction and Enforcement

Jacqueline called Marshfield and Rockland, the people she spoke to had no answers. Basically, no one enforces their restrictions

Water study will look at seasonal fluctuations and we hope to use that data to focus outreach next spring. Becky to reach out to Tighe and Bond to see if things like boaters' water use and private wells show up in the Water System Study

5. End of Year Planning

Finish municipal BMPs and Water Offset. Next year, irrigation restriction regulations.

Becky to send Water Conservation Plan and Summary of recommendations to WRC to bring any other ideas to the next meeting.
