2. Water System Updates

Water Department update – Becky read from Mark's update

- Reservoir is -46.0", Tack Factory Pond is -14.5".
- Rainfall in the last 7 days = 0.9" (not including last night), as measured at the TP. State has us in a level 2 Significant Drought as of 9/8.
- Demand for the past 7 days including the holiday:

Wells – 6,743,520 Gallons

TP – 1,744,000 Gallons

Total = 8,487,520 Gallons or 1,212,502 Average gallons per day. Down slightly from the previous holiday week.

- The production from our well water is slowly declining due to the water table dropping as a result of the drought.
- Full Water Ban started late Tuesday August 2, 2022. Total ban on all nonessential outside water use.
- Continuing to issue violations to anyone violating the Total Ban.

Brown Water update

- Manganese is still elevated at the TP but coming down with the cooler night temperatures. All manganese sampling (in house) for the SWTP was below .2 mg/l.
- Still lots of people coming in for bottled water

3. Open discussion

Bob DeLorenzo suggested putting together a group of interested citizens with certain expertise to investigate using desalination to supplement our water resources. He will put this group together and bring their findings back to the WRC.
